Annual Report 2022-23

The session began with Student Induction Programme for freshers. A week of various activities was planned according to UGC guidelines and conducted with enthusiasm. The activities ranged from sessions on Choice Based Credit System, Learning on SWAYAM, guidance by alumni and guest lectures to cultural programme and nature walk in our campus rich in bio-diversity. Freshers also availed of teachers' guidance at Bridge course conducted during 25 to 30 July 2022.

Students of B.Voc. degree programmes once again made us proud by appearing on the merit list of the University's summer examination 2022. Sopan Mohe, Bharat Chopade and Uday Shinde of B.Voc. (Vehicle Testing) bagged the first, second and third merit respectively. Piyush Patekhede stood first merit from B.Voc. (Farm Equipment & Machinery). From the B.Voc. (Engine Testing) programme, Nikhil Gore and Jayesh Jogi stood first; Darshan Suryawanshi, Vilas Lande and Ramsingh Rajput stood second and Aniket Girhe third merit at the university examination.

Students also won accolades in sports. The fencing team won bronze medal at intercollegiate competition and was included in the university team. Mahesh Dhole B.A.I won bronze in 1000 m running. Dhawan Sakharkar and Pratik Dhangale of BA I were selected on the fencing team for all India interuniversity competition. Riya Yadav of B.Lib.I.Sc. won bronze medal at inter collegiate university level competition; was included in the university team and participated in the All India interuniversity competition. Our students participated in Quiz Competition at the university youth festival on 13 Oct 2022. Our NCC cadet Yogesh Rathod was selected for Malvankar Camp at Nasik and cadet Mansab Shaikh got first rank in firing. Sangita Thak from SW also bagged medal for first in firing at TCA camp at Amravati.

The degree distribution programme was held on 25th August 2022 with Sub Divisional Officer, Rajendra Jadhav and our alumnus, Block Development Officer, Shivshankar Bharsakale as the chief guests. Meritorious students were felicitated along with their

parents. The college was approved Research Centre in Marathi and three students have been enrolled.

The college hosted the intercollegiate university Kabaddi Competition for zone A from 10 to 12 December 2022. Guest lectures by Dr. Sangita Pawar on 2nd August 2022 and Dr. Meghraj Shinde on 20 April 2023 were organizing by the deptt. Of History. The English department conducted a guest lecture on 18th April 2023 on English Language for Employability. The Resource person was Dr. D. T. Adhau G.S. College, Khamgaon. The department also conducted an online quiz on the memories of William Shakespeare on 23rd April 2023. Nutrition week was celebrated through e-poster competition and competition on protein-based recipes.

National Science Day on 1st March and Annual gathering on 17th and 18th March were held with enthusiasm. Mother tongue day and Marathi *Rajbhasha* Din were celebrated in February while the annual inter-collegiate debate competition was held on 29th March 2023 on the topic, 'Party-hopping is leading to degradation of political values'. The ICC organized a counselling programme by the Damini Pathak, Police Station, Khamgaon on 26 April 2023.

Field visit to Shivangi Bakers, MIDC and Kshirsagar Flowers and Decorators and organization of an event management programme, Block printing demonstration by the Home Economics department gave hands on experiential learning to students. Students of BVoc availed of 30 days' experiential learning in automobile workshop under the MoU with Tata Motors workshop in Khamgaon.


