Serious Scientific Misconduct | Fraud | Intentional Dishonesty.

Intellectual property theft / piracy: Robbing people or companies of their ideas, inventions, and creative expressions—known as "intellectual property"—which can include everything from trade secrets and proprietary products and parts to mavies, music, and software.

Plagiarism: Is "The act of academic dishonesty, stealing, misappropriation of another person's intellectual property (iP) which includes: ideas, inventions, original works of authorship, words, slogans, designs, proprietary information, etc. and using them as your own without proper acknowledgment and/or permission of the original author or inventor."
